Dr. Stefano Pallanti is a "Physician-Scientist" who applies cutting-edge neuroscience breakthroughs to clinical work by utilizing clinical activities to formulate research hypotheses. He is a NIMH grant co-PI in Theta Burst Stimulation of pathological gamblers.

He is Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Florence and Director of the Institute for Neurosciences in Italy. He is Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Stanford University Medical Center, Stanford, CA, USA, where he works as TMS Consultant, Visiting Professor at Albert Einstein College of Medicine, New York, USA, Visiting Professor at Imperial College, London, UK and Adjunct Associate Professor at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, New York, USA, where he served as the Founder and Director of the Strategic Center of Excellence for OCD, Impulsive and Behavioural Addiction.

Dr. Stefano Pallanti is an Executive Committee Member, a Scientific Board and a Chair of Neuromodulation Network of ECNP (European College of Neuropsychopharmacology) and serves on its Educational Committee. He is the Advisory Council member of the International Center for Autism Research and Education (Icare4autism, New York), an international fellow and Advisory Board of the American Psychiatric Association for the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, for DSM-IV and for the Obsessive Compulsive Disorder Spectrum Workgroup for the DSM5.

He is a member of the board of directors of the International College for Obsessive-Compulsive Spectrum Disorders (ICOCS), a member of the PANDAS Physicians Network and of the International Neuroethcs Society.

Since 2014 he has been a board member for World Health Organization as an expert on anxiety. He served as a member of board of directors of the Clinical TMS Society from May 2013 to May 2017. He is a member of the New York Society of Psychiatry.

In 2019 Dr Pallanti is appointed a faculty and speaker of the International Psychopharmacology Course of the Harvard University and Massachusetts General Hospital Psychiatry Academy and of the Training School at Clare College, Cambridge University, UK for the European Network for Problematic Usage of the Internet.

He is particularly active in rTMS, Neuromodulation, Photo-Bio Modulation and Vagus Nerve Stimulation covering a broad area of Neuro Psychiatry. He is Editor of Archive of Behavioral Addiction, Deputy Editor of CNS Spectrums, where he is also a columnist. He has published 194 peer reviewed papers, 12 books, 4 manuals of Psychiatry and his H index is 55 as of April 2020.
